Dear Prospective EMU Students,

Human beings are constantly in a process of learning during their lifespans. University is an important institution that contributes to both personal and academic development in this learning process. The EMU Entrance and Scholarship Exam, which holds a critical position in the commencement of university life, expects you to demonstrate the knowledge and skills, you have acquired throughout your school years, within a specified timeframe. At times, various reasons may make this task challenging. One of the most common reasons encountered is anxiety related to the exam. It is possible to say that anxiety, as an emotion, serves as a motivating and functional feeling. However, nowadays, numerous factors such as the significance attached to exams, negative self-assessment of one's own potential, and high expectations from family and peers can intensify exam-related anxiety. Intense anxiety can adversely affect your performance in the exam, even if you have prepared sufficiently. Therefore, in addition to adequately preparing for the exam, learning to cope with anxiety is also vital during this process. Below, you can find some tips that may help you prepare for the exam and navigate the exam process in a healthier manner.

While Preparing for the Exam...

- Make sure that your goals and expectations regarding life is realistic.
- Identify your strategy for studying, manage your time and set up a program. Try to stick to your study program. Do not postpone or change your study schedule.
- Manage your time wisely. Ensure that you have sufficient time to study, sleep, eat and relax.
- Your physical well-being, emotions and ideas are always in interaction with each other. Therefore, both your physical and psychological health must be your most important priority.

Just Before the Exam...

- Do not neglect regular sleep and balanced nutrition.
- Take time for relaxing in the days leading up to the exam. Watching a fun movie, spending time with a good friend or going for a walk can be good for you.
- Go over the important information such as the place and time of the exam. Make sure you do the necessary arrangements in order to be present at the exam place on time.
- Plan ahead for what you can do in situations where anxiety may manifest in intense physical symptoms (*such as sweating, trembling, hot flashes, nausea, etc.*). Learning relaxation techniques* could be beneficial.



Day of the Exam...

- Allocate sufficient time to have breakfast and get ready.
- Do not forget to bring necessary documents for entering the exam (*Identity Card and Exam Entry Document*).
- Make sure that you have necessary materials (pencil, eraser, etc.) for the exam.
- Leave the course materials at home; going over the course materials on the last day will make you more anxious.
- Attend to your basic needs such as restrooms or water, before the exam.
- Avoid talking to other candidate students about the exam or the difficulty of the exam which would provoke your anxiety.
- Manage your time wisely during the exam. Read the instructions and exam questions carefully, pay attention to the announcements/warnings to be made by the invigilators.
- To start the exam by solving questions related to the topics you feel more confident about will help you relax.
- Do not compare yourself with others by looking around and observing what they are doing during the exam.
- Be in a positive dialogue with yourself, do not demoralize yourself (*For instance; "I have worked hard for this exam, I will do my best"*).
- If your anxiety is in a level which distract you from focusing, take a deep breath and try to relax.

***Relaxation Technique:**

Sit up straight in order to take a deep breath. Inhale slowly through your nose and feel your breath pushing down your diaphragm. Then, exhale slowly through your mouth. Taking deep breaths will help regulate your heart rate and blood pressure. Repeat this breathing exercise several times until you refocus on the exam.



1. What is EMU – Entrance and Scholarship Exam 2024?

EMU – Entrance and Scholarship Exam 2024 is an exam held by the Eastern Mediterranean University concerning the placement of students to undergraduate and associate degree programs who will qualify to study in the Eastern Mediterranean University in the 2024 – 2025 Academic Year and, the determination of students who will be awarded with a scholarship during the same academic year.

2. Who can apply?

Students who meet the following criteria can apply for the EMU – Entrance and Scholarship Exam 2024:

- TRNC citizen students who are graduates or graduate candidates of a high school or an equivalent school providing education either in TRNC or abroad,
- Republic of Turkey (*TR*) citizen students who uninterruptedly (*within 4 years*) completed or soon to complete their high school training in an educational institution in TRNC,
- Foreign-national students who completed or soon to complete their high school training in an educational institution in TRNC (*valid only for students who are to apply for the Joint Medicine and Dentistry Programs*),
- Foreign-national students who do not hold TR citizenship and completed or soon to complete their high school training in an educational institution in the Republic of Turkey (*valid only for students who are to apply for Joint Medicine and Dentistry Programs*).

n.b.:

- While applying for the exam, foreign-national students must specify the language (*Turkish or English*) in which they will take the exam.
- Foreign-national students who are to apply for programs other than Medicine Faculty, Dentistry Joint Programs and, Faculty of Pharmacy must submit their applications via <https://applyonline.emu.edu.tr/>.

3. How can I apply for EMU – Entrance and Scholarship Exam 2024?

Applications for the EMU – Entrance and Scholarship Exam 2024 can be submitted online through the application system which will be accessible on EMU website (<https://www.emu.edu.tr/>) between 02 and 31 May, 2024 (*until 11:59 p.m.*). Candidates experiencing any problems with the online application process must contact with EMU Registrar's Office within the working hours.

Necessary documents to be uploaded to the system while submitting the application;

- A) Student candidates who graduated in the previous years: High School Diploma
- B) All candidates: Passport photograph
- C) Candidates who hold TRNC citizenship:
Scanned front and back side pictures of TRNC Identity Card in pdf, jpeg, etc. format.
(Candidates with dual citizenship must only upload the scanned front and back side picture of TRNC Identity Card.)
- D) Candidates who are citizens of Republic of Turkey:
 - Scanned front and back side pictures of Republic of Turkey Identity Card in pdf, jpeg, etc. format.
 - An authentic document certifying that high school training was uninterrupted received (*4 years*) in an educational institution in TRNC.
- E) Candidates who are foreign-nationals (*valid only for students who are to apply for Joint Medicine and Dentistry Programs*):
 - A scanned picture of the passport's page with a photo in pdf, jpeg, etc. format.
 - Transcript and an authentic document showing that the candidate student is to complete high school training and to graduate from an education institution in TRNC and Republic of Turkey.

While applying, each candidate is required to make preferences for at least 1 and maximum of 8 programs specified in Table 1. Candidates who completed the application procedures but would like to make changes on their preferences specified in their application must contact the Registrar's Office in person at the latest of 31 May 2024 in order to make such changes. yapabilirler.

5. Date, Time, Location and Duration of the Exam

EMU - Entrance and Scholarship Exam will be held on Sunday, 02 June 2024 between 10:30 a.m. and 01:00 p.m., in one session, at the exam centers specified below:

On the exam day, the candidates must be present at the exam center at the latest of 10:00 a.m.



n.b.: Candidates who arrive at the exam centers within the first 30 minutes after the commencement of the exam, will be able to sit the exam however, additional time will not be given for the first 30 minutes of the exam. Candidates who arrive at the exam centers after the first 30 minutes will not be allowed to sit the exam and, therefore the candidates will not have any right to make requests in this regard.

6. Application Fee

Applications for EMU – Entrance and Scholarship Exam 2024 will be free-of-charge.

7. Exam Calendar

8. Exam Entry Document

An Exam Entry Document consisting of a photo and personal details of the candidate will be prepared by the system once, the candidate fully completes the application procedures. The name-surname, candidate number, exam hall where that specific candidate will take the exam will be written on the said document. Each candidate will be able to sit the exam in the exam hall specified on the Exam Entry Document. Candidates are required to bring a printed copy of the Exam Entry Document on the day of the exam.

9. Necessary Documents to Enter the Exam

Candidates will be allowed to enter the exam halls after they present the Exam Entry Document and an authentic photo-bearing document, certifying who is to take the exam. If the Exam Supervisor suspects something odd in the identity of a candidate, s/he holds the right to not allow the candidate to sit the exam upon the approval of Exam Center Responsible.

10. Materials Necessary During the Exam

Candidates must bring at least two soft-tipped black pencils, a pencil sharpener and a high quality eraser which does not leave stains.

11. Tools and Materials that are not allowed in the Exam Hall

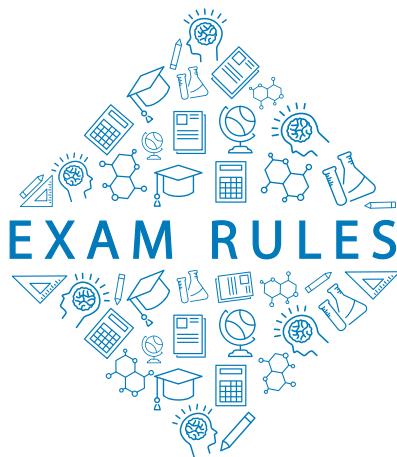
It is not allowed to bring dictionaries, calculators, handbooks, books, worksheets, photograph apparatus, cameras, pagers, smart watches and similar communication devices into the exam hall. Mobile phones must be turned off. The exams of candidates whose mobile phones are not turned off will be deemed invalid.

12. Exam Rules

- Candidates will be able to enter exam halls as of 10:00 a.m. on the condition of presenting the Exam Entry Document and identity card or an authentic photo-bearing document certifying the identification.
- Candidates are required to take the exam in the exam hall specified on their Exam Entry Documents.
- All mobile phones must be turned off in the exam hall.
- Once the candidates receive their exam booklets, they must check all the pages in the booklet, ensuring there is no missing pages in the booklet. If the booklet has printing errors, it should be submitted to the Exam Supervisor.
- The accuracy of the information written on the answer sheet must be checked, in an event of false information, an official report must be recorded and submitted to the Exam Supervisor.
- The Exam commences following the “The exam has commenced” statement of the Exam Supervisor.
- Candidates entering the exam cannot leave the exam hall within the first 30 minutes and the last 10 minutes of the exam.
- Candidates who arrive at the exam hall within the first 30 minutes after the commencement of the exam, will be able to sit the exam however, additional time will not be given for the first 30 minutes of the exam. Candidates who arrive at the exam hall after the first 30 minutes will not be allowed to sit the exam.
- Candidates performing acts in a way that would break the peace and disrupt the exam environment during the exam are warned by the invigilators. Candidates who continue exhibiting such behavior even though they have been warned, are removed from the exam hall and their exam is deemed as invalid.
- All candidates sitting the exam are required to sign the attendance list during the exam. Do not leave the exam hall before you sign the attendance list.
- Candidates who engage in acts such as cheating, attempting to cheat, helping others to cheat and providing answers for the questions will be recorded in the Exam Hall Report and, their exam is deemed as invalid.



- The Exam Commission is entitled to deem the exams of all candidates invalid in an exam hall, if the exam rules are not appropriately implemented.
- All candidates are required to write their name, surname and ID numbers on the exam booklets.
- The answer sheet must be filled in solely with a pencil.
- The spare sections in the exam booklet can be used for taking notes during the exam.
- Candidates are not allowed to share pencils, erasers or similar tools.
- Candidates can bring beverages such as water, cola or juice. However, utmost care should be performed not to harm the answer sheet.
- Additional time will not be given for transferring the answers onto the answer sheet. Candidates are responsible for transferring the answers on the answer sheet within the duration of the exam.
- Candidates are obliged to submit the exam booklet and the answer sheet to the invigilator before they leave the exam hall. The exam of any candidate who does not submit the Exam booklet and/or answer sheet before leaving the exam hall will be deemed invalid.
- The exam ends with “The exam has ended” statement of the Exam Supervisor.



13. Tests Included in the Exam

Following tests will be included in the EMU – Entrance and Scholarship Exam 2024. Each test consists of 30 questions. Each candidate should answer the tests that are necessary for their program preferences' required score types (*See Table 1 and Table 3*).

Name of the Test	Who will answer the test?
Turkish Test	All candidates*
Literature and Social Sciences Test	All Candidates whose program preferences require TM (Turkish-Mathematics), TS (Turkish-Social Sciences) and ID (English Language) points
Mathematics - 1 Test	Candidates whose program preferences require TM and TS points
Mathematics - 2 Test	Candidates whose program preferences require MF (Mathematics-Science) points
Science Test	Candidates whose program preferences require MF points
English Language Test	Candidates whose program preferences require ID points and, foreign-national candidates who choose to take the exam in English language

* If the foreign-national candidates choose to take the exam in Turkish language.



14. Exam Booklets

The booklets will be in two different types, consisting of same questions. The booklet type which is specified as A or B on the cover of the booklet, must be chosen in the relevant section on the answer sheet. Candidates are obliged to write their name, surname and candidate number in the allocated sections on the exam booklet. The exam of the candidates who do not specify the booklet type will be deemed as invalid. All exam booklets will be submitted to invigilators at the end of the exam.

15. Which tests should I answer?

Table 3 explains the necessary score types through which undergraduate and associate degree programs will accept students. The tests required by score types and their weights according to score types are shown in **Table 1**. Candidates must respond to the tests required by the score types of the programs they prefer.

n.b.: Table 1 and Table 3 will also be printed on the back page of Exam Booklet.

16. Filling in the Answer Sheet

- Answer sheets should be handled with care to avoid wrinkling or folding since they will be evaluated with an optical scanner.
- Candidates must only use pencils while filling in the answer sheet.
- Each answer sheet will be printed with a student name and will be sent to the exam hall where the specific student will sit the exam. Therefore, candidates are obliged to enter the exam in the exam room specified on the Exam Entry Document.
- The answer sheet will include information on the name/surname of the candidate, exam center, exam hall and the candidate number will be already filled in prepared for the student. The candidate is responsible for checking the accuracy of these information. In an event of any misspelling and/or coding error on the answer sheet, candidate is responsible for informing the Exam Supervisor on the matter. The Exam Supervisor records such errors on the Exam Hall Report.
- Following the distribution of the Exam Booklets, the booklet type must be encoded in the relevant section of the answer sheet.

- Answer sheet includes sections for all test types. Each question has a correct answer. Candidates must encode their answers on the corresponding option by completely filling the circle.
- In an event of encoding more than one options for a question, the relevant question will be deemed as incorrectly answered.
- In an event of deciding to change a previously encoded answer, the previous answer must be thoroughly erased before encoding the new answer.

17. Music Talent Exams for Candidates who are to prefer Music Teaching Program

Music Scholarship and Talent Exam:

18. Evaluation of the Exam

While evaluating the exam, a quarter of the score value corresponding for a correct answer in the relevant test will be deducted for each incorrect answer. No points will be deducted for unanswered questions.

If a question is cancelled for any reason, the cancelled question will not be included in the evaluation and its score value will not be reflected to the other questions.

Following score types of the candidates will be calculated;

- MF** Mathematics – Science Score
- TM** Turkish – Mathematics Score
- TS** Turkish – Literature and Social Sciences Score
- ID** English Language Score



19. How is the EMU – Entrance and Scholarship Exam 2024 Score Calculated?

The EMU – Entrance and Scholarship 2024 Scores of the candidates depend on the Actual Achievement Score (AAS) in each test.

The AAS is calculated as specified below:

$$\text{AAS} = \text{Number of correct answers} - [(\text{number of incorrect answers}) / 4]$$

After calculating the AAS, the calculation depending on the relevant score type is as follows:

$$\text{MF} = 10 \times [[(4/3) (\text{AAS Math2})] + [(4/3) (\text{AAS Science})] + [(2/3) (\text{AAS Turkish})]]$$

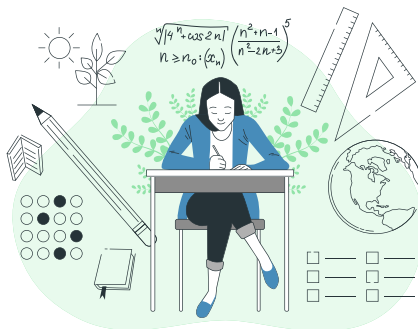
$$\text{MF} = 10 \times [[(4/3) (\text{AAS Math2})] + [(4/3) (\text{AAS Science})] + [(2/3) (\text{AAS Turkish/English}^*)]]$$

$$\text{TM} = 10 \times [[(4/3) (\text{AAS Math1})] + [(4/3) (\text{AAS Turkish})] + [(2/3) (\text{AAS Lit.SoS.})]]$$

$$\text{TS} = 10 \times [[(2/3) (\text{AAS Math1})] + [(4/3) (\text{AAS Turkish})] + [(4/3) (\text{AAS Lit.SoS.})]]$$

$$\text{ID} = 10 \times [[(3/3) (\text{AAS Turkish})] + [(2/3) (\text{AAS Lit.SoS.})] + [(5/3) (\text{AAS English})]]$$

Sample Score Calculation

A sample score calculation for a candidate whose test results in the EMU – Entrance and Scholarship 2024 would be as follows:

Test Answers	AAS Calculation
Mathematics – 1 Test: 25 correct and 5 incorrect	AAS Math1 = $25 - (5/4) = 23.75$
Mathematics – 2 Test: 15 correct, 7 incorrect and 8 unanswered	AAS Math2 = $15 - (7/4) = 13.25$
Science Test: 15 correct and 15 incorrect	AAS Science = $15 - (15/4) = 11.25$
Turkish Test: 24 correct and 6 incorrect	AAS Turkish = $24 - (6/4) = 22.50$
Literature and Social Sciences Test: 20 correct, 6 incorrect and 4 unanswered	AAS Lit.SoSci. = $20 - (6/4) = 18.50$
English Language Test: 22 correct, 6 incorrect and 2 unanswered	AAS English = $22 - (6/4) = 20.50$

The candidate receives the following score with the above-provided points (when calculating, the final score is rounded to two decimal fractions):

$$\mathbf{MF = 10 \times [(4/3) (AAS Math2)] + [(4/3) (AAS Science)] + [(2/3) (AAS Turkish)]}$$

$$MF = 10 \times [(4/3) (13.25)] + [(4/3) (11.25)] + [(2/3) (22.50)] = 476.67$$

$$\mathbf{TM = 10 \times [(4/3) (AAS Math1)] + [(4/3) (AAS Turkish)] + [(2/3) (AAS Lit.SoSci.)]}$$

$$TM = 10 \times [(4/3) (23.75)] + [(4/3) (22.50)] + [(2/3) (18.50)] = 740.00$$

$$\mathbf{TS = 10 \times [(2/3) (AAS Math1)] + [(4/3) (AAS Turkish)] + [(4/3) (AAS Lit.SoSci.)]}$$

$$TS = 10 \times [(2/3) (23.25)] + [(4/3) (22.50)] + [(4/3) (18.50)] = 701.67$$

$$\mathbf{ID = 10 \times [(3/3) (AAS Turkish)] + [(2/3) (AAS Lit.SoSci.)] + [(5/3) (AAS English)]}$$

$$ID = 10 \times [(3/3) (22.5)] + [(2/3) (18.5)] + [(5/3) (20.5)] = 690.00$$

20. Announcement of the Questions, the Answer Key and the Scores

The EMU – Entrance and Scholarship Exam 2024 questions and answer keys will be announced on the exam day at 02:00 p.m., on the other hand, the exam performances (*numbers of correct/incorrect answers*) of the candidates will be evaluated on the same day to be announced on EMU website (www.emu.edu.tr).

21. Appealing to Exam Results

Candidates can appeal to the exam results until 04:00 p.m., Monday, 03 June 2024 by sending an e-mail to sinavitiraz@emu.edu.tr e-mail address. The e-mail submitted for the appeal must include information regarding the booklet type, name of the test, number of the question, reason for appealing and a mobile number for accessing the person who submitted the appeal. EMU Exam Committee can also be contacted for appeals (0533 834 85 00). The evaluation results of the appeals will be sent to the appealing person via an e-mail, on Tuesday, 04 June 2024.

22. Placement into the Programs

Within the framework of the quotas and according to the preferences submitted by the candidates during the application process, each candidate will be placed in a program. The placement lists and exam scores will be announced on EMU website after 08:00 p.m. on Tuesday, 04 June 2024.

23. Open Admission (Admission without Exams)

TRNC citizen and TRNC-TR Dual citizen students will be admitted to programs (*excluding International Joint Programs (Medicine and Dentistry) and Music Teaching Program*) based on the Secondary Achievement Score within the framework of quotas. In this regard, students to be admitted will not be able to benefit from scholarship opportunities.

Foreign-national students will be admitted to programs (*excluding International Joint Programs (Medicine and Dentistry)*) based on the Secondary Achievement Score within the framework of quotas.

Applications for open admission:

can be submitted to EMU Registrar's Office in person after the EMU – Entrance and Scholarship Exam 2024.

Refer to 'Final Registration Procedures', Article 25, for documents necessary for the application.



24. Tuition Fees and Achievement Scholarships

Information on the tuition fees to be applied for new EMU registrations in 2024 – 2025 Academic Year can be obtained through “EMU- New Student Tuition Fee Searching System”. The system can be accessed from the link below: <https://portal.emu.edu.tr/YeniOgrenciOgrenimUcreti.aspx>

Tuition fee applied for TRNC citizen students is also applied for the Republic of Turkey (*TR*) citizen students who uninterruptedly (*within 4 years*) completed or soon to complete their high school training in an educational institution in TRNC.

Tuition fee determined for foreign-nationals applied to international students who completed or soon to complete their high school training in an educational institution in TRNC.

In accordance with the EMU – Entrance and Scholarship Exam 2024 results, three candidates placed in each program (*except for Medicine and Dentistry programs*) who meet the below-mentioned criteria are granted scholarships with respect to their success rankings; one candidate with 100% scholarship, one candidate with 75% scholarship and one with 50% scholarship. Students ranked within the top three in the success list who share the same score with other candidate are granted the same scholarship. The scholarship only covers the tuition fee.

Following the ranking of the candidates who are placed in programs other than Medicine and Dentistry;

- a 100% scholarship for Undergraduate Programs is awarded to students with a score of 600 or above, for Associate Programs 350 or above.
- a 75% scholarship for Undergraduate Programs is awarded to students with a score of 550 or above, for Associate Programs 350 and above.
- a 50% scholarship for Undergraduate Programs is awarded to students with a score of 500 or above, for Associate Programs 300 or above.
- If the number of scholarships awarded in each program based on the criteria mentioned above is less than 3, then for each scholarship not awarded, 50% scholarship will be granted to candidates in order of placement, provided that they have obtained a minimum of 400 points for undergraduate programs and 250 points for associate degree programs.

Candidates who are to register at EMU will receive uninterrupted scholarship within the duration of the

relevant program, not being subject to any other conditions. In programs where English Preparatory School training is required, a maximum of one year can be added to the specific duration.

25. Final Registration Procedures

The right to register to be granted as a result of the EMU – Entrance and Scholarship Exam 2024 is only valid in the 2024 – 2025 Academic Year Fall Semester. Candidates who do not register within the dates announced by EMU will lose their rights to register in an EMU program.

Candidates must consult to the EMU Registrar's Office with the below-mentioned documents in order to complete their final registration procedures:

- Authentic high school diploma or a diploma from an equivalent educational institution with 6 copies,
- A copy of TRNC Identity Card (*for only TRNC citizens or TRNC/Republic of Turkey citizens*),
- Document certifying that the student uninterruptedly (*4 years*) completed his/her high school training in an educational institution in TRNC (*for only Republic of Turkey citizens*),
- A copy of Republic of Turkey Identity Card (*for only Republic of Turkey citizens*),
- 6 copies of recently shot passport photographs,
- Payment receipt indicating semester tuition fee deposited to the EMU account.

26. Student Admissions via International Exams

Within the framework of the specified quotas, all EMU programs accept students via international examinations (*GCE A Level, GCE AS Level, IGCSE – GCSE O'Level, ABITUR, SAT, etc.*)

TRNC TOP STUDENT OF THE HIGHSCHOOL 100% SCHOLARSHIP	Student candidates who are eligible to register for any program at Eastern Mediterranean University (<i>except for Medicine and Dentistry programs</i>) within the year they graduated from the high school, and who have obtained the highest graduation score in their relevant high school or equivalent institution in the TRNC with a grade of 'pekiyi' (<i>excellent</i>) are entitled to a 100% scholarship applied to the tuition fee they are obliged to pay.
SUCCESSFUL ATHLETE SCHOLARSHIP	The scholarship awarded to an athlete representing Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) at a level accepted by the University Executive Board in a sporting event, where they achieve first place either individually or as part of a team, or who actively participates in one of the EMU Sports Clubs and has become a national athlete in their own field in their country, provided that they continue an active and successful sports life at the University. The scholarship covers all or part of the tuition fees or accommodation fees in EMU dormitories. The scope, duration, and conditions of the scholarship are determined by the University Executive Board and regulated by the "Eastern Mediterranean University Athlete Scholarship Implementation Principles", which are approved by the Board of Trustees.

If both parents of the relevant student are EMU graduates, a 50% discount is applied (<i>excluding Medicine and Dentistry programs</i>).
SIBLINGS DISCOUNT	In undergraduate or associate degree programs (<i>excluding Medicine and Dentistry programs</i>), a 25% tuition fee discount is applied (<i>for each student</i>) for the first two siblings meeting the criteria, and a 75% tuition fee discount is applied for the third and subsequent siblings. The discounts applied to three siblings are also applicable if there are two siblings and one parent enrolled in undergraduate or associate degree programs. Students enrolled in graduate programs who do not receive any discounts or contributions based on the semester tuition fee from the University are eligible for a sibling discount of up to 10% of the tuition fee.
PERSONNEL DISCOUNT (50%)	Children of EMU staff (including personnel who have worked at the University for at least fifteen years and retired starting from the academic year 2012-2013) receive a 50% tuition fee discount if they enroll in any program at EMU (<i>excluding certificate programs</i>).
